Best Practices for Administering State Assessments in the Schoolhouse

Always Maintaining social distancing.

Ensuring staggered arrival and departure times.

Sanitizing rooms and student workstations and/or computer equipment every day.

Assigning the same desk to students back-to-back on subsequent administration days.

Providing sufficient pencils so that they need not be returned or disinfected after use.

Ensuring the use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) by students and staff.

Conducting health screenings at home each day (students and staff).





All students and staff members must always wear a mask while on campus.



Social distancing guidelines will be followed.



Students will be seated apart in the testing room.




Hand sanitizer is provided but students may also bring their own for personal use.



Students in Grades 7 and 8 must bring their own headphones/earbuds (NO AIRPODS).



Students may bring their own #2 pencils.

MSO Students

MSO students will test separate from PHY students.

Grade 3 Opportunities for Promotion

- Section 1008.25, Florida Statutes (F.S.), Eliminating Social Promotion.
 - Spring FSA English Language Arts (Level 2 or Higher)
 - Spring Grade 3 Reading Student Portfolio
 - I-Ready Diagnostic Assessment period 3, administered the last two weeks of school
 - Alternative Assessment for Grade 3 Promotion (AAGTP)—SAT-10, Primary 3, administered in Summer School
 - Grade 3 Mid-Year Promotion (GTMYP)—Assessments administered in October/November 2021

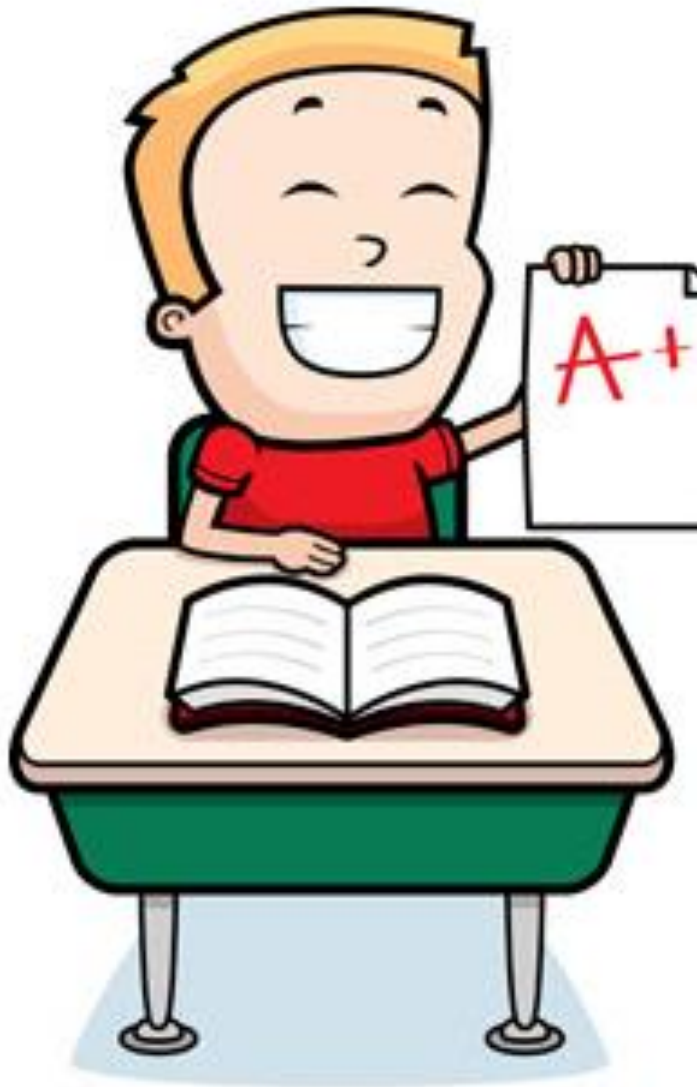
